Required equipment: Each student will need their own handgun (they can rent one if needed) and bring their own ammunition - 300 rounds (they can buy from us if needed). They must also bring a duty belt with a holster (no shoulder or ankle holsters for safety purposes) and a magazine pouch. In addition, each student should be wearing long pants and shoes (no sandals or open toe footwear).
