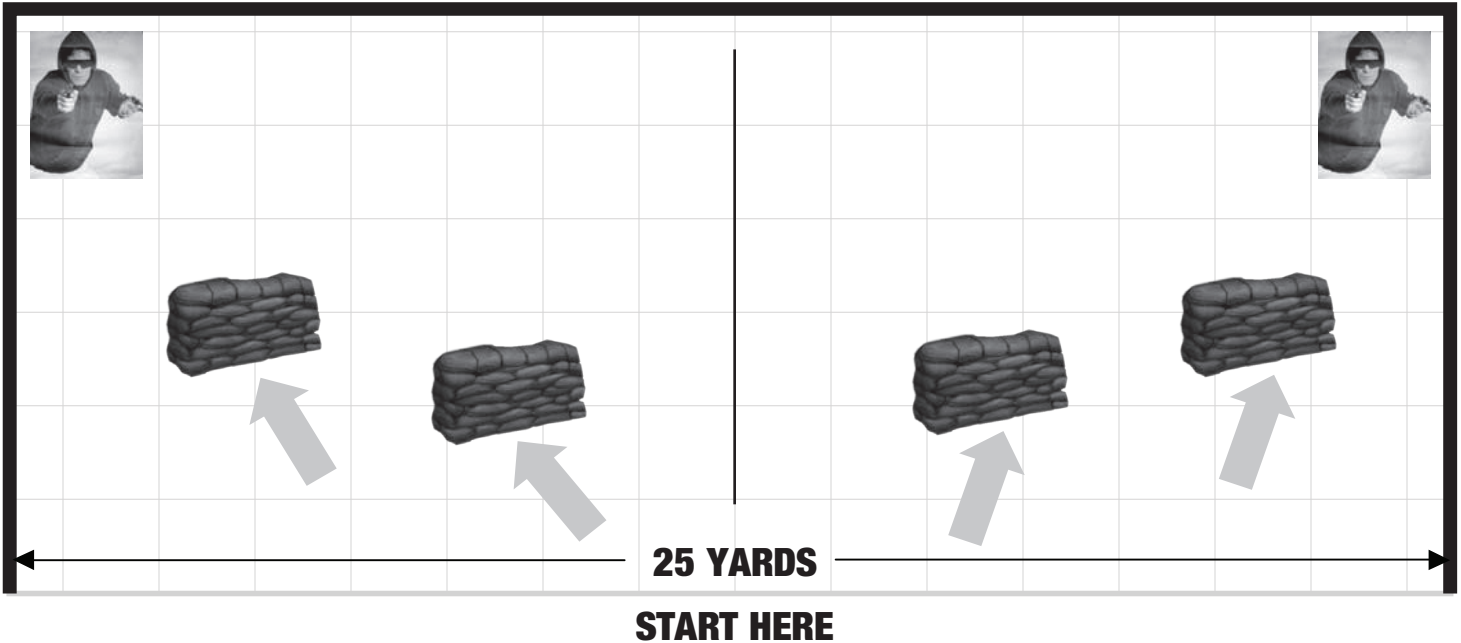


OFFICER DOWN

Relevancy: Simulates a situation where the officer is shot in the strong hand, yet must continue to fight assailant(s) in order to save innocent lives.

Objective: To effectively and safely operate your patrol rifle to engage hostile targets using movement and cover with your weak hand, arm, and shoulder.

Safety: All shooting must be conducted from the standing position. Charging and reloading must be conducted using the muzzle stops to pin the rifle muzzle in the muzzle stop and the butt of the weapon to the shooters shoulder/chest (see example to the right). The muzzle stops are located at the starting position and at each barricade. No other technique may be used. Shooters may not transition to their pistol and they may not shoot on the move. All shooting must be done at the barricades. MUZZLES MUST REMAIN POINTED DOWN RANGE WITHIN THE DESIGNATED LIMITS OF THE RANGE AND BACKSTOP.



**Acceptable
Technique**

NOTE:

1. All charging, reloading, and malfunction clearance operations must be done at the designated muzzle stop location points.
2. Techniques using the corner of a barricade, your gun belt, holster, or other appendage on your person to charge the weapon is PROHIBITED.
3. The rifle must be shouldered when firing. You may not fire from an UNDER-ARM shooting position.

Load: 10 rounds (two mags with 5 and 5 rounds respectively).

Range: 25 yards / **Time:** 40 seconds / **Target:** LE-26

Start: Weapon is in the “Car carry condition” on the deck of the starting line. The shooters weak hand will be zip tied behind their back.

STEP 1: Upon command to fire the shooter must charge the weapon using the muzzle stop and then move to the 1st barricade keeping the muzzle pointed down range.

STEP 2: At the 1st barricade fire 5 rounds at the target, conduct a reload using the muzzle stop, and move to the 2nd barricade keeping the muzzle pointed down range.

STEP 3: At the 2nd barricade fire five rounds at your target.

Scoring: (500 points possible)

Body: 25 points per hit **Head:** 50 points **Miss:** - 25 per miss
