Basic Police Sniper School Confirmation Letter

Monday's training schedule is classroom all morning, range in the afternoon & classroom in the evening. The pace of this course is tremendous. Expect long hours. You must bring a "can do" attitude and the proper gear. Physical training (pushups & sit-ups) are not incorporated into this training. However, you will do your share of running and crawling no matter what the environmental conditions may be like. You will find this course demands your full attention. There are no excuses for failure as a police sniper. As such, we teach you the basics and demand you perform under the same pressure and circumstances you could encounter on your first call out, as if it were scheduled to occur immediately after graduation. **Expect a night shoot on either Tuesday or Wednesday night.**

Standards: On days 2 thru 4 your cold bore shots are fired for a score. These three cold bore shots must average 60%. Failure to meet this standard disqualifies you from the written examination and qualification course on Friday. You will receive a certificate of attendance. On Friday morning you will take a comprehensive written examination. Failure to score 70% disqualifies you from shooting the qualification course and you will receive a certificate of attendance. After passing these requirements you must pass a four-phase qualification course of fire which includes shooting from various positions at ranges from 25-200 yards. You will get three attempts to pass each phase. Failure to pass any one phase disqualifies you and you will receive a certificate of attendance. After passing each phase you are a certified graduate of our Basic Police Sniper School.
